



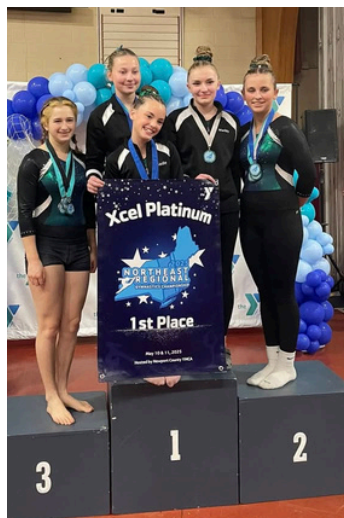

A MESSAGE FROM THE CEO

Looking back at all that we accomplished together in 2025, one word stands out: resilience. Over the past year, our YMCA navigated a period of transition and uncertainty while continuing to grow, evolve, and deepen our impact in the communities we serve.

We began the year facing uncertainty around federal funding for several YMCA programs. Like many nonprofits, we were reminded how essential strong community support is to sustaining the work we do every day. Time and again, our staff, members, partners, and donors stepped forward with the commitment and creativity that make our Y so special.

2025 was also a year of important transitions for our association. In the summer, we celebrated the leadership of CEO Rob Gray as he concluded his tenure, and I was honored to step into the role of CEO after serving as Chief Operating Officer. Around the same time, we marked the retirement of one of the most remarkable leaders in our Y's history—Long Reach Swim Club Head Coach Jay Morissette. After 40 years of service and an incredible 35 state titles, Jay leaves behind a legacy that has shaped generations of swimmers and strengthened the spirit of our YMCA community.

Even amid these changes, our Y continued to reach exciting milestones. We proudly opened the doors of our new Early Learning Center in Brunswick through our historic childcare partnership with General Dynamics Bath Iron Works. We also broke ground on our long-awaited childcare center at the Bath Y, marking the beginning of the final phase of our years-long \$7.9 million capital campaign. Members at the Landing Y are already enjoying a new bouldering wall, and both branches introduced new fitness classes to keep our community active and connected. With the support of community partners, we also expanded opportunities and programming for teens across our community.

As we reflect on this year, we are also preparing to celebrate a remarkable milestone: the 170th anniversary of our association. For nearly two centuries, our YMCA has adapted and grown to meet the changing needs of our community. That legacy continues today through the dedication of our staff, the generosity of our donors, and the energy of our members.

Thank you for being part of our Y. Your generosity, commitment, and passion make our YMCA—and our community—a better place for all.

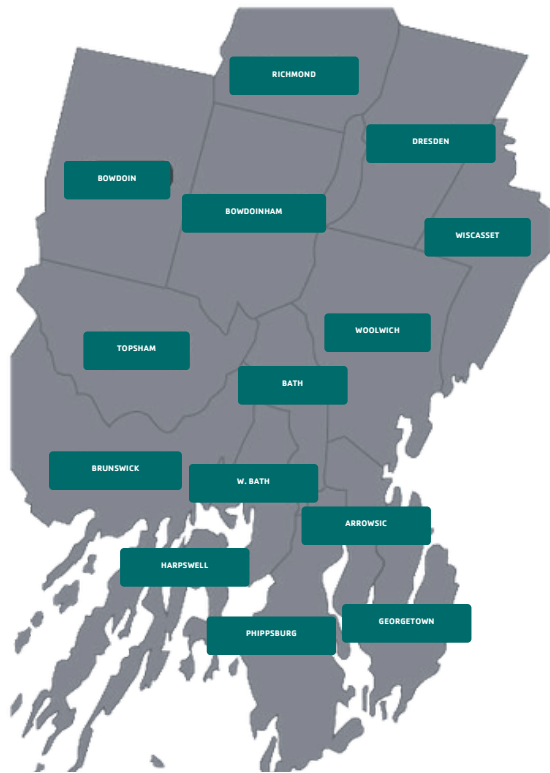

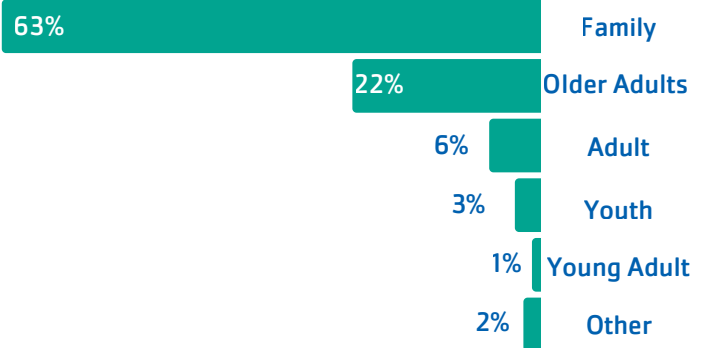

FINDING YOUR Y: STEVE NAKAMURA

For twenty years, I bowed onto training mats nearly every day at our Pittsburgh dojo as well as across the New England states and even the Shaolin Temple. I've earned black belts, taught thousands of students, and dedicated my life to the philosophy and practice of martial arts.

Two years ago, I found myself in a different kind of ring—coaching Rock Steady Rock Steady Boxing classes challenge both body and mind through high-intensity, non-contact boxing training that focuses on balance, coordination, strength, and voice. Like martial arts training, progress comes through discipline and repetition. Boxers drill combinations week after week, building confidence, reinforcing neural pathways, and strengthening both body and mind. Just as important is the community that forms in every class—coaches, volunteers, and fellow boxers encouraging one another through every round.

Every person who walks through the Rock Steady doors embodies the indomitable spirit we talk about in martial arts—the refusal to surrender in the face of overwhelming odds. Parkinson's is an opponent that never tires and never retreats, yet they show up, put on their gloves, and fight back.

At the end of each class, we form a circle, throw a hand into the center, and shout together: "1, 2, 3—Rock Steady!" When I say goodbye to each boxer, I'm bowing internally to the fighting spirit in front of me. Every day, I'm honored to stand in their corner.

FINDING YOUR Y: JACKSON SALVE

I started swimming for Long Reach Swim Club about a month into swim lessons when Coach Jay Morissette noticed my efforts. He told my mom that I didn't need to be in lessons and that I should be on the team.

Coach asked me to do a couple things, I think they were a somersault and then another one off the wall. I guess I did good enough because he said "see you next week". Nine years later, I'm still swimming competitively.

LRSC is my second family, without a doubt. I never felt out of place when I was on deck or in the water. This last year, I would say most of my success was because of LRSC, either because the practices were more challenging and I got better at swimming, or because I felt I owed my best to the team. Swimming for LRSC took up my afternoon and I wouldn't change that for anything.

The biggest takeaway that I have gotten from swimming at the Y is: "Live and Die as a Team". This is the phrase that Coach Sponge brought in this year. And I will live the rest of my life with this in mind, because this got me through the year.



FINDING YOUR Y: THE LOOK FAMILY

Our family chose the YMCA's enrichment and preschool programs because we wanted more than childcare—we wanted a place that truly understands how children learn and grow. We were a little nervous moving from a small home-based setting to a larger program, but from day one our minds were put at ease by the caring staff, beautiful outdoor grounds, and leadership that prioritizes child development and play.

What sets this YMCA apart is its commitment to outdoor, play-based learning. The Adventure Trail, the Burrow, the Rocks, and the Chicken Playground give children space to develop balance, imagination, and confidence. My son even leads our family to his favorite spots during YMCA hikes. Along with outdoor exploration, he benefits from Music Together, weekly swim, and thoughtful classroom experiences with loving teachers who prepare children for kindergarten while helping them grow into independent, kind, and capable young people.

We are deeply grateful for the YMCA and the positive impact it has had on our family. The extra events—family hikes, the Halloween fun run, swim activities, and the holiday trolley ride—create joyful experiences that build community and celebrate every child.

FINDING YOUR Y: MAGGIE LIMM

Food and the YMCA: these are two of my favorite things! Since retiring from my job at a K-8 school, I have spent a lot of time doing various volunteer gigs, but truly none has been as rewarding as the work I do with the Bath YMCA's Food Programs.

Every other Thursday, I head over to the MidCoast Hunger Prevention Program in the "famous" YMCA Veggie Van to pick up and deliver boxes of groceries to our homebound neighbors in Brunswick. I am grateful for the opportunity to bring fresh produce, meat, and groceries to people who wish to remain independent and healthy in the community.

Last summer, fellow YMCA Board member Nancy Kaake and I drove around in the Veggie Van, delivering premade meals to families throughout Bath—my own kids were never so pleased to see me coming with breakfast in hand! We loved seeing our regulars and hearing about their summer plans to take their lunches to the beach, to the lake, or to the park.

But hands down, my very favorite thing is to spend time packing veggies and groceries with Jeff and Judy Peavey every to be deliver to over 45 families with school-age children in the Bath area. The food is pretty basic, nothing fancy: tuna, mac and cheese, cereal, carrots, apples, potatoes, turnips (sorry, kids), but it's nutritious, it's cost-effective, it's child-friendly, it's consistent, and most importantly it fills a critical need for children. Kids can play, can learn, can be good friends, can be good citizens of the world, and can simply be kids when their most basic needs are met and that is what the YMCA Food Programs do.

EARLY LEARNING CENTER CAMPAIGN

Closing the final chapter in our childcare expansion campaign

In 2021, in response to the overwhelming demand for quality, affordable childcare in our community, the YMCA began developing plans for a capital campaign to expand our early childhood education program. What started as an ambitious vision to serve more families has, over the past five years, grown into a transformational effort for our Y and the communities we serve.

Today, thanks to the generosity and support of so many individuals and organizations, that vision is becoming a reality. Over the course of this \$7.9 million campaign, our nationally accredited program has expanded from three classrooms serving 35 children to nearly 200 infants, toddlers, and preschoolers across two centers. Each of these spaces is filled with opportunities for learning, growth, and connection during the most important years of a child's development.

2025 marked a major milestone in this journey. We proudly opened the doors to our new 10-classroom Early Learning Center in Brunswick, built in partnership with General Dynamics Bath Iron Works. And we broke ground on the final phase of our campaign: a six-classroom addition at the Bath YMCA.

This new space will be known as The Haggett Family Early Learning Center, honoring the late Bill Haggett - former president of Bath Iron Works, longtime YMCA board member, and past board president - and his wife Sally, whose tireless advocacy and dedication to the Y helped make this work possible.

If you have visited the Bath YMCA recently, you've likely seen the progress taking shape on campus. Construction is well underway, and we look forward to opening the doors of this new center in the fall of 2026. As we bring this campaign to a close, we are in a strong fundraising position and hopeful we will reach our goal by early spring.

We are deeply grateful to the many members of our community who have supported this effort. This project is about far more than expanding our physical space. It is a promise to our children, our families, and our future—and a reflection of the strong, caring community that continues to make our work possible.
